

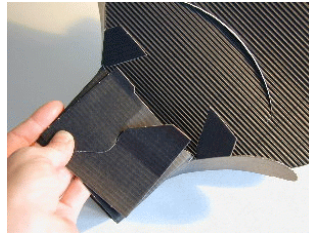
Display Stand Template

Print directly onto paper to be used for stand, or transfer onto it if paper can not be run through printer. Can also be enlarged or reduced with copier for different sized stands.

Be sure to construct stand from heavy paper. Corrugated paper works well.

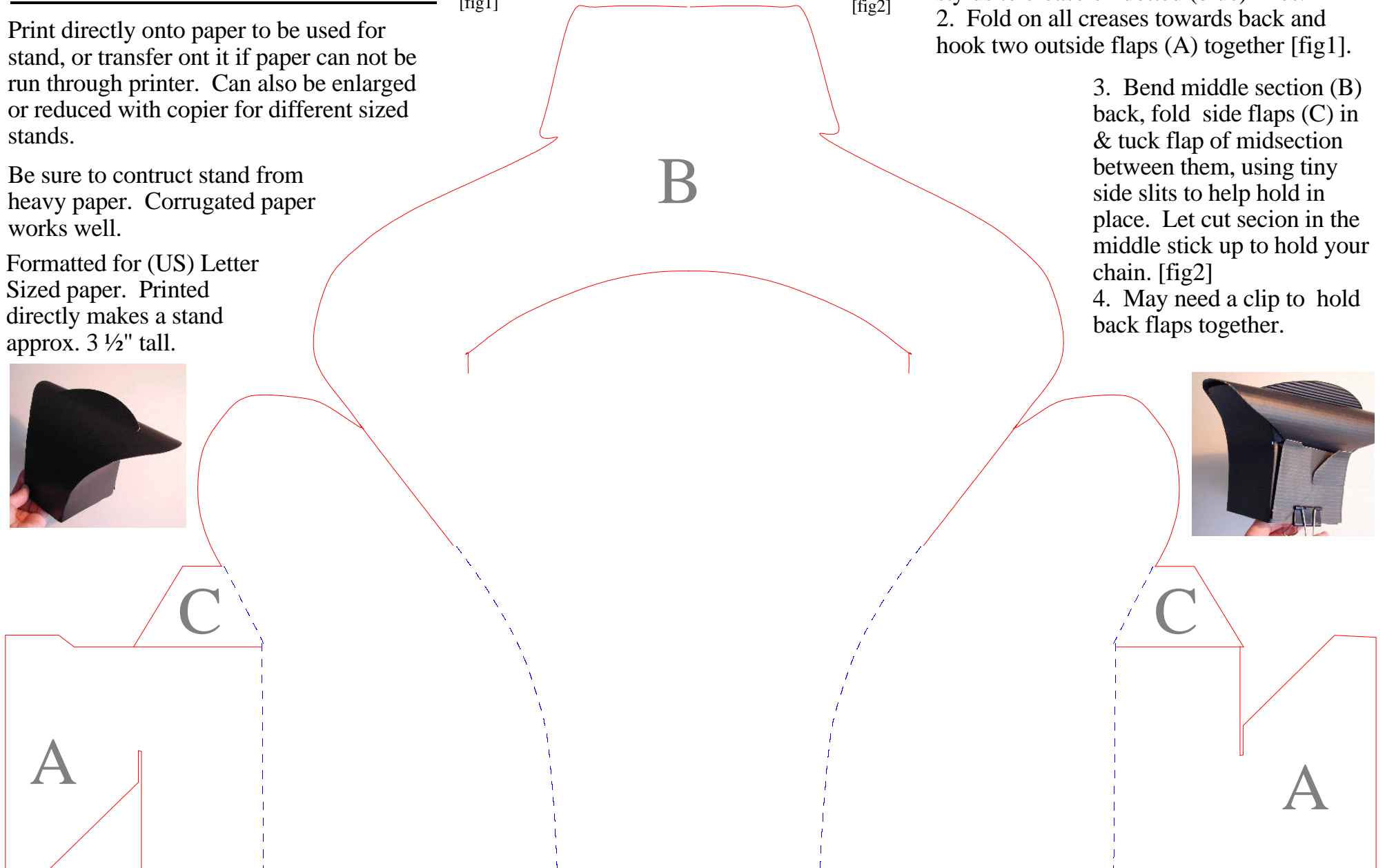
Formatted for (US) Letter Sized paper. Printed directly makes a stand approx. 3 1/2" tall.

— Cut line
- - - Crease & fold line

1. Cut on all solid (red) lines & use a stylus to crease on dotted (blue) lines.
2. Fold on all creases towards back and hook two outside flaps (A) together [fig1].

3. Bend middle section (B) back, fold side flaps (C) in & tuck flap of midsection between them, using tiny side slits to help hold in place. Let cut section in the middle stick up to hold your chain. [fig2]

4. May need a clip to hold back flaps together.
